Follow the Rules

- 1. I can follow the rules to keep me and the fish safe
- 2. Outside, I can walk ONLY on the paths
- 3. Inside where I can watch the fish through the underwater windows, I can use my quiet voice
- 4. To keep the fish safe, I will try to keep my hands away from the windows while I'm watching the fish.
- 5. I will stay with my family or group, but if I get separated, I can ask a Fishway staff member for help. Staff members wear blue shirts.



Sensory Bags

If I am feeling overwhelmed I can go to the entrance and ask for a sensory bag to borrow while I am here.

Sensory bags include:

- Lanyard and ID badge/sticker
- Noise cancelling headphones
- Water timer
- Squishy toy
- Copy of the social story booklet



Learning about Fish

The Fishway Staff will be happy to talk to me about fish. The staff will talk to me outside so they don't disturb other visitors.






I will go inside and downstairs to look through the underwater windows.

Fish Ladder

I can also see the fish ladder that helps migrating fish get past the dam.

To see the fish ladder, I will take a short walk on a path from the Fishway, along the canal.

Sometimes water flowing in the canal and over the dam is very loud and moving very fast.

If I don't want to walk across the bridge I do not have to.
