

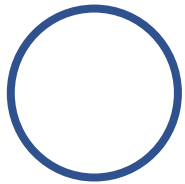

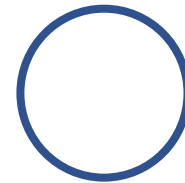




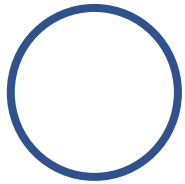
My Checklist for Visiting Shepaug Eagle View Observatory



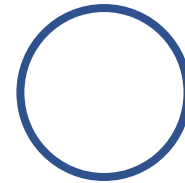
I am going to watch bald eagles at the Shepaug Dam



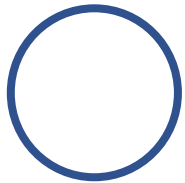
I can look through the telescope to see the eagles and other birds



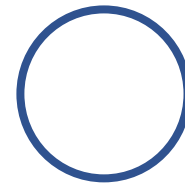
I will wear warm clothes because it is winter and I will be outside
